The love which can:

Do anything to be with you & Please you for seeing you happy

Hurt oneself to give you comfort & also Support you in your goals

Keep check on you if are on right path & also Point - speak - correct you if needed

The kind love love which broadly covers all the positive aspects of earlier 4 loves & also is much more than that.

The kind of love

in which you can do anything to fulfil the demand of your loved ones

In which you care for your loved one more than you

In which you are even ready to be labelled as a wrong one for helping your loved ones in reaching their goal.

This is a kind of love which we call belongs to another dimension as compare to the earlier four loves we discussed.

Example of this love are:

- + Our Freedom Fighter's love for our country,
that they did not hesitate even to sacrifice their lives for their love.
- + When you see scientists submerged into their research
- + When you see artists emerged in their creation
- + When you see athletes breaking their bodies for their sport
- + When you see our soldiers fighting for our country
- + When you see animals giving their lives to save their humans
- + When you see a Meera dipped in love of her Krishna

There can be many such examples around us;
But the most appropriate and common example to describe this kind of love is
A Mother's Love For Her Children.

The Common Phrases related to this kind of love is

“Deewanapan”

“Woh toh life hai uski”

“Ashiqi ho to Shaheed Bhagat Singh jaisi”

*“She loved her daughter so much that for her daughter’s growth,
she let her go far away from her.”*

“Duniya ki parwaah nahi karte ye log”

When you ask them questions like:

“Tumne apne pyaar k liye itna kuchh kiya tumhe kya mila..?”

They will say :

“Pyar ka kaam sirf dena hota hai, lena nahi.”

Points To Remember

I think Sant Kabir has beautifully described this kind of love in this doha:

*“प्रेम गली अति संकरी, तामें दाऊ न समाई ।
जब में था तब हरी नहीं, अब हरी है में नाहीं ।*

The street of love is very narrow, two can't pass through it at the same time
When I was, there was no God (Hari), now there is God but I am not.”

What To Do:

Just feel blessed and thankful that we have ever received this kind of love.

And make sure to make the one who loved us like this,
feel proud of their choice of loving us.
